Sir,

In continuation of this Ministry's letter of intent of even number dated 24.2. 2005 and with reference to your letter dated 15.3.2005, I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Government to the establishment of a new medical college in the name and style of " Shadan Institute of Medical Sciences, Research and Teaching Hospital" at Peerancheru, R.R. Distt. by Shadan Educational Society, Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh with an annual intake of 150 (one hundred fifty only) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic session 2005-06 under Section 10 (A) of IMC Act, 1956 as amended.

2. This permission of the Central Govt. for establishment of the college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievement of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The college shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission. The college shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council of India norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.

3. This permission is subject to the Bank Guarantees of Rs. 9.50 crores (2.00 crores towards medical college and Rs. 7.50 crores for hospital facilities) valid for five years furnished by Shadan Institute of Medical Sciences, Teaching Hospital & Research Centre, Hyderabad for the establishment of medical college and hospital found to be adequate/genuine on all counts. The admission process for the academic year 2005-06 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended.
